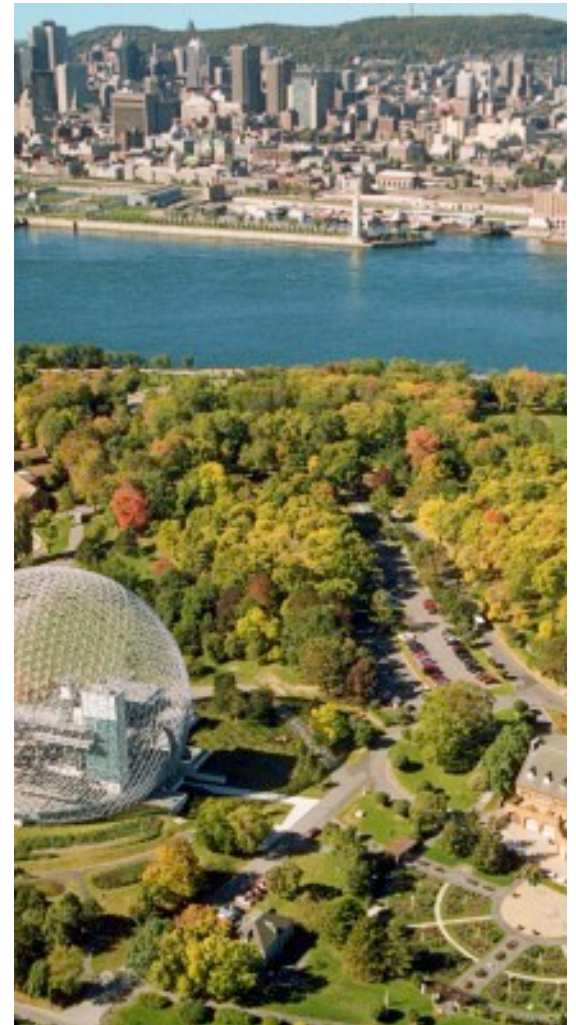

Facts about Montreal, Canada

- * second largest city in Canada, and the largest city in Canada's province of Quebec
- * Montreal is an island; it is surrounded by the St. Lawrence, Ottawa and Prairies rivers.
- * Montreal was initially called Ville-Marie (City of Mary). In 1775 it became known as Montreal
- * Population of 1.6 million people
- * French is the city's official language
- * 60% of the homes speak French, 20% speak English
- * Montreal is the second primarily French-speaking city in the world, second to Paris, France
- * Summers are humid, temperatures range from 70 to 80 degrees F
- * The lowest temperature recorded in history in Canada is -36 degrees F in January of 1957!
- * The metro underground subway system is the most common form of travel serving 1.1 million daily passengers
- * Currency in Montreal is the Canadian dollar
- * The most popular sport in Montreal is ice hockey, and the teams Montreal Canadiens have won 24 Stanley Cups, the most in NHL history.
- * Mount Royal Park was designed by Frederick Olmsted, the same person who conceived Central Park in New York City
- * Montreal is one of Canada's most important ports to transport sugar, grain, oil, and machinery
- * Montreal lies at the base of Mount Royal and this mountain lies in a large wooded park that extends to the center of the city
